REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS

(OWNERS ARE ADVISED TO NOTE THE FOLLOWING:-)

1. **REGISTRATION OF HUNTER CERTIFICATE - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

By signing the hunter certificate and submitting for registration certifies that:-

(a) The details of age, sex and pedigree are correct and that the horse's name is registered under the Rules of Racing.

(b) The Master's declaration on the certificate is correct and that the horse has been satisfactorily qualified with the said Hunt and is qualified to be entered for any Hunter Steeple Chase run under the Rules of Racing and any race run under the Point-to-Point Regulations for which it is eligible.

(c) I/We agree to be bound by the British Horseracing Authority Point-to-Point Regulations or part thereof currently in force.

Register in plenty of time. This is particularly important if you are registering a horse to run from 26th November 2011 onwards and in particular over the Christmas period.

TO BE ENTERED IN A POINT-TO-POINT Steeplechase (other than Hunt Members races held under Regulation 72) the Certificate must be registered by noon on a Friday to qualify the horse for entry for meetings whose entries close on or after the following Monday. Please note earlier registration dates for meetings staged during the Christmas period. Please refer to the National Planner.

However, if a Bank Holiday falls on a Friday then all Certificates must be registered by 12noon on the day before ie Thursday.

TO BE ENTERED IN HUNTER STEEPLE CHASES the Certificate must be registered by noon the day before entries close (normally 6 days prior to the race meeting except for race meetings on a Saturday, which will normally close 5 days prior).

However, it should be noted that registration will not occur on a Saturday, Sunday, Bank Holiday, Good Friday or Christmas Day but by noon on the first day thereafter that the Racing Calendar Office is open for business.

2. **REGISTRATION OF NAME**

This Certificate cannot be registered until the Name of the Horse is registered under the Rules of Racing. If you are in any doubt as to the identity of this Horse, please contact the Names & Passport Section, Racing Administration, Weatherbys, Sanders Road, Wellingborough, Northants, NN8 4BX, before completing this form.

N.B. There is no necessity for either Names registration or Hunter Certificate registration to be effected if horses are to be entered and run solely in Hunt Members races but owners must submit the Hunter's Certificate to the Point-to-Point Secretary with their entry for this race.

3. **PASSPORTS**

The owners of all horses running in Hunter Steeple Chases and Point-to-Point Steeple Chases will be required to produce a Passport for inspection on the course which must contain records of all vaccinations against Equine Influenza. Please check that your horse has been correctly vaccinated in accordance with the conditions laid down in Regulations 35 and 36 of the Regulations for Point-to-Point Steeple Chases.

4. **HUNTER CHASES**

For entry in Hunter Steeple Chases (not Point-to-Point Steeple Chases) all owners must be on the Register of Owners and have Racing Colours officially registered. For advice on all aspects of ownership and for the relevant application forms, please contact the Ownership Desk, Racing Administration, Weatherbys, Sanders Road, Wellingborough, Northants, NN8 4BX.

An Owner Registration will become effective the day after approval. **N.B. Approval of an application will normally take a minimum of 24 hrs from receipt of the application. This means for example, an application received on a Monday would normally be effective on a Wednesday.** Registrations of Racing Colours and Joint Ownership will be effective from the day of receipt of the respective registration forms, provided the colours requested are available and the partners are registered owners.

If you intend to make entries for Hunter Steeple Chases you will require a Security Code. If you have not been issued with one please contact the Horses In Training section, Racing Administration. Weatherbys. **Furthermore, all horses running in Hunter Steeple Chases must be microchipped.**

5. **OWNERS' RESPONSIBILITY**

All owners are reminded that, as stated in the Point-to-Point Regulations, they have certain responsibilities, whether they train the horse themselves or it is trained by someone else. Owners are strongly advised to consult the current copy of the Regulations for Point-to-Point Steeplechases and before making entries to check all relevant details contained in the Point-to-Point Race Planner. 6. **Owners are informed that should any of their horses running in Point-to-Point races consistently fall, unseat or show unruly behaviour they may have their Hunter Certificate suspended for the remainder of the season. The performance of all horses is monitored and owners will be contacted if a Hunter Certificate suspension is being considered.**

7. **MANDATORY PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE COVER FOR OWNERS**

Owners should be aware that £4.55 of the Hunter Certificate fee covers a contribution to a mandatory liability insurance policy covering horses from the time of arrival until departure from a Point-to-Point and those participating in Hunter Chase races staged on licensed racecourses. Further details will be sent to Owners with confirmation of registration of this certificate.

8. **DEFRA HORSE PASSPORTS REGULATIONS**

DEFRA legislation now requires that all horse passports contain declaration pages necessary to endorse whether the horse is or is not ultimately destined for human consumption. **Since February 2005, failure to be able to present passports containing these declaration pages can result in prosecution under the Animal Health Act.** We strongly advise you to check for the presence of the necessary pages within the passport. A fee of £5 (inc. VAT) will be due to the British Horseracing Authority for each set of pages issued. The BHA advise that horses are declared not for human consumption to allow a full range of medicines to be used.

9. **POINT-TO-POINT AUTHORITY HORSE SPONSORSHIP SCHEME (HSS)**

In order to enjoy the benefits of the HSS, the business name of the sponsor (maximum 45 characters including spaces) must be added to this Hunter Certificate. The business name may NOT appear in any racecard nor on any paddock sheet until this registration is confirmed (in a letter from Weatherbys) and the appropriate fee £53.68 inc. VAT has been paid. For further detailed information on the scheme, please refer to Appendix L of the British Horseracing Authority Regulations for Point-to-Point Steeple Chases or download the appropriate information from pointtopoint.co.uk.
